- 1 AN ACT Relating to insurance coverage for insurance agents and
- 2 brokers; and amending RCW 48.17.150.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 48.17.150 and 1988 c 248 s 9 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) To qualify for an agent's or broker's license an applicant must 7 otherwise comply with this code therefor and must
- 8 (a) be eighteen years of age or over, if an individual;
- 9 (b) be a bona fide resident of and actually reside in this state,
- 10 or if a corporation, be other than an insurer and maintain a lawfully
- 11 established place of business in this state, except as provided in RCW
- 12 48.17.330;
- 13 (c) be empowered to be an agent or broker, as the case may be,
- 14 under its members' agreement, if a firm, or by its articles of
- 15 incorporation, if a corporation;
- 16 (d) complete such minimum educational requirements for the issuance
- 17 of an agent's license for the kinds of insurance specified in RCW
- 18 48.17.210 as may be required by regulation issued by the commissioner;

- 1 (e) successfully pass any examination as required under RCW 2 48.17.110;
 - (f) be a trustworthy person;

- 4 (g) if for an agent's license, be appointed as its agent by one or 5 more authorized insurers, subject to issuance of the license; ((and))
- 6 (h) if for broker's license, have had at least two years experience
 7 either as an agent, solicitor, adjuster, general agent, broker, or as
 8 an employee of insurers or representatives of insurers, and special
 9 education or training of sufficient duration and extent reasonably to
 10 satisfy the commissioner that he or she possesses the competence
 11 necessary to fulfill the responsibilities of broker; and
- (i) obtain and maintain insurance covering the licensee's liability
 for errors and omissions in an amount and type specified by the
 commissioner.
 - (2) The commissioner shall by regulation establish minimum continuing education requirements for the renewal or reissuance of a license to an agent or a broker: PROVIDED, That the commissioner shall require that continuing education courses will be made available on a state-wide basis in order to ensure that persons residing in all geographical areas of this state will have a reasonable opportunity to attend such courses. The continuing education requirements shall be appropriate to the license for the kinds of insurance specified in RCW 48.17.210: PROVIDED FURTHER, That the continuing education requirements may be waived by the commissioner for good cause shown.
- 25 (3) If the commissioner finds that the applicant is so qualified 26 and that the license fee has been paid, he <u>or she</u> shall issue the 27 license. Otherwise, the commissioner shall refuse to issue the 28 license.
