- 1 AN ACT Relating to the release of lighter-than-air balloons; adding
- 2 new sections to chapter 70.94 RCW; creating a new section; and
- 3 prescribing penalties.

State of Washington

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the release into
- 6 the atmosphere of large numbers of balloons inflated with lighter-than-
- 7 air gasses poses a danger and nuisance to the environment, particularly
- 8 to wildlife and marine animals.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 70.94 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, it is
- 12 unlawful for any person to intentionally release, organize the release,
- 13 or intentionally cause to be released within a twenty-four hour period
- 14 ten or more balloons inflated with a gas that is lighter than air.
- 15 (2) It is not a violation of this section for a person to release:
- 16 (a) Balloons on behalf of a government agency or pursuant to a
- 17 governmental contract for scientific or meteorological purposes;
- 18 (b) Hot air balloons that are recovered after launching; or

- 1 (c) Balloons indoors.
- 2 (3) A violation of this section is a class 1 civil infraction under
- 3 chapter 7.80 RCW.
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 70.94 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Any person may petition a district court to enjoin the release of
- 7 ten or more balloons in violation of section 2 of this act.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** If any provision of this act or its
- 9 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 10 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 11 persons or circumstances is not affected.
