1 AN ACT Relating to educational service districts; and adding a new
2 section to chapter 28A.310 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.310
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 (1) In addition to other powers granted under this chapter the
7 board of directors of each educational service district may exercise
8 the following:

9 (a) The broad discretionary power to determine and adopt written
10 policies not in conflict with other law that provide for the
11 development and implementation of programs, activities, services, or
12 practices that the board, upon the request of a school district or
13 districts served by the educational service district, determines will
14 support the education of preschool through twelfth grade students in
15 the public schools or support the effective, efficient, or safe
16 management and operation of the school district or districts served by
17 the educational service district;

18 (b) Such powers as are expressly authorized by law; and

1 (c) Such powers as are necessarily or fairly implied in the powers
2 expressly authorized by law.

3 (2) Before adopting a policy under subsection (1)(a) of this
4 section, the educational service district board of directors shall
5 comply with the notice requirements of the open public meetings act,
6 chapter 42.30 RCW, and shall also include in that notice a statement
7 that sets forth or reasonably describes the proposed policy. The board
8 of directors shall provide a reasonable opportunity for public written
9 and oral comment and consideration of the comment by the board of
10 directors.
