- 1 AN ACT Relating to administrative searches; and adding a new
- 2 section to Title 4 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to Title 4 RCW to 5 read as follows:
- 6 The person or agency applying for an administrative search warrant
- 7 shall give notice of an application for a warrant to the owner and
- 8 occupant of a residence or other place to be inspected at least twenty
- 9 days before the warrant is issued. The owner or occupant is entitled
- 10 to a hearing before issuance of the warrant, if a hearing is requested.
- 11 The warrant must be limited in scope to that necessary to perform the
- 12 inspection. The warrant should be served during regular business hours
- 13 if possible, but in no case may the warrant be served after 7:00 p.m.
- 14 Without a warrant, an administrative search may only be conducted
- 15 with the fully informed consent of the occupant. The consent must be
- 16 in writing to be valid. As used in this section, "administrative

- 1 search warrant" means a noncriminal warrant issued to do administrative
- 2 inspections.
