- 1 AN ACT Relating to court commissioners in municipal court; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 3.50 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 3.50 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- One or more court commissioners may be appointed by a judge of the municipal court. Each commissioner holds office at the pleasure of the
- 8 appointing judge. A commissioner authorized to hear or dispose of
- 9 cases must be a lawyer who is admitted to practice law in the state of
- 10 Washington or a nonlawyer who has passed the qualifying examination for
- 11 lay judges for courts of limited jurisdiction under RCW 3.34.060.
- 12 A commissioner need not be a resident of the city or of the county
- 13 in which the municipal court is created. When a court commissioner has
- 14 not been appointed and the municipal court is presided over by a part-
- 15 time appointed judge, the judge need not be a resident of the city or
- 16 of the county in which the municipal court is created.
