- 1 AN ACT Relating to student organizations' access to higher
- 2 education institutions' registration and student account systems; and
- 3 adding new sections to chapter 28B.15 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Unless the context clearly requires
 - otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout sections 2
- 7 through 5 of this act.
- 8 (1) "Voluntary student fee" means fees, other than tuition or
- 9 services and activities fees, that students may voluntarily elect to
- 10 pay during the registration process at the state's community colleges,
- 11 regional universities, The Evergreen State College, and state
- 12 universities.

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- 13 (2) "Registered student organization" means an organization
- 14 registered with, recognized by, or affiliated with the student
- 15 governing association.
- 16 (3) "Negative check-off system" means students that do not want to
- 17 participate exercise their option by a negative response.

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- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Registered student organizations soliciting
- 2 voluntary student fees shall fully disclose the use of such fees and
- 3 use fees for only such disclosed student purposes. The administration
- 4 may charge a reasonable user fee to registered organizations that use
- 5 the registration and student account system.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** (1) All registered student organizations
- 7 with access to an institutional registration and student account system
- 8 on or before September 30, 1991, shall continue to have access to the
- 9 institutional registration system until the beginning of the 1995-96
- 10 academic year.
- 11 (2) Beginning in the 1995-96 academic year and every third academic
- 12 year thereafter, in order to continue access to the academic
- 13 registration and tuition payment system, established registered student
- 14 organizations shall receive a majority of votes from the recognized
- 15 undergraduate student governing association.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** All registered student organizations that
- 17 have not had access to the registration and student account system
- 18 before September 30, 1991, but desire access to the academic
- 19 registration and tuition payment system shall complete the following
- 20 process:
- 21 (1) Registered organizations shall obtain the signatures of fifteen
- 22 percent of registered full-time students on petitions supporting
- 23 placing the issue on the general election ballot;
- 24 (2) Registered organizations shall obtain approval by a majority of
- 25 participants in a vote of the student body; and
- 26 (3) The organizations shall repeat this process every three years
- 27 to continue access to the registration and tuition payment system.
- 28 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** (1) Registered student organizations that
- 29 are granted access to the system may determine the amount of voluntary
- 30 contributions they request each quarter or semester.
- 31 (2) Students shall choose to contribute the voluntary student fee
- 32 by a negative check-off system.

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- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** Sections 1 through 5 of this act are each
- 2 added to chapter 28B.15 RCW.

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
