- 1 AN ACT Relating to public works subletting and subcontracting;
- 2 adding a new section to Title 39 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to Title 39 RCW to 5 read as follows:
- Every invitation to bid on a contract that is expected to cost in 7 excess of one hundred thousand dollars for the construction,
- 8 alteration, or repair of any public building or public work of the
- 9 state or a state agency or municipality as defined under RCW 39.04.010,
- 10 an institution of higher education as defined under RCW 28B.10.016, or
- 11 a school district shall require each bidder to submit as part of the
- 12 bid, or within twenty-four hours of the bid, the names of the
- 13 subcontractors whose subcontract amount is more than ten percent of the
- 14 contract price with whom the bidder, if awarded the contract, will
- 15 subcontract for performance of the categories of work designated on the
- 16 list to be submitted with the bid or to indicate by naming itself that
- 17 a category of work on the list shall not be subcontracted. Failure to
- 18 name such subcontractors or itself shall render the bidder's bid
- 19 nonresponsive and, therefore, void.

- 2 retroactively. It applies only to invitations to bid issued on or
- 3 after the effective date of this act.
