1 AN ACT Relating to public works subletting and subcontracting;
2 adding a new section to Title 39 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to Title 39 RCW to
5 read as follows:

6 Every invitation to bid on a contract that is expected to cost in
7 excess of one hundred thousand dollars for the construction,
8 alteration, or repair of any public building or public work of the
9 state or a state agency or municipality as defined under RCW 39.04.010,
10 an institution of higher education as defined under RCW 28B.10.016, or
11 a school district shall require each bidder to submit as part of the
12 bid, or within twenty-four hours of the bid, the names of the
13 subcontractors whose subcontract amount is more than ten percent of the
14 contract price with whom the bidder, if awarded the contract, will
15 subcontract for performance of the categories of work designated on the
16 list to be submitted with the bid or to indicate by naming itself that
17 a category of work on the list shall not be subcontracted. Failure to
18 name such subcontractors or itself shall render the bidder's bid
19 nonresponsive and, therefore, void.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act applies prospectively only and not
2 retroactively. It applies only to invitations to bid issued on or
3 after the effective date of this act.

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
