1 AN ACT Relating to penalties for driving under the influence of  
2 liquor or drugs; adding a new section to chapter 46.61 RCW; and  
3 prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7 A person who is convicted of a violation of RCW 46.61.502 or  
8 46.61.504 is subject to a mandatory minimum fine of five hundred  
9 dollars and a mandatory five days of community service in a program  
10 benefiting children if the person committed the violation while  
11 transporting a person seventeen years of age or younger.

12 On a second or subsequent conviction of a violation of RCW  
13 46.61.502 or 46.61.504 a person is subject to a mandatory minimum fine  
14 of one thousand dollars and a mandatory ten days of community service  
15 in a program benefiting children if the person committed the violation  
16 while transporting a person seventeen years of age or younger.

1       The fines or mandatory service imposed under this section are not  
2 subject to suspension.
