- 1 AN ACT Relating to audits of services for veterans; and creating a
- 2 new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislative budget committee shall conduct an examination of the department of veterans affairs, the Washington soldiers' home at Orting, and the Washington veterans' home at Retsil. The examination shall specifically address:
- 8 (a) The quality of patient care at the Washington soldiers' home 9 and the Washington veterans' home to determine the quality of patient 10 care and whether staffing ratios and funding are sufficient; and
- 11 (b) A determination as to whether funds in the revolving funds 12 governed under RCW 72.36.120 and 72.36.130 are being expended for the 13 benefit and welfare of the members of these homes, and whether any of 14 these funds are being inappropriately transferred to administrative 15 offices in Olympia.
- 16 (2) To ensure that there is no duplication of effort, prior to 17 conducting the examination, the legislative budget committee shall 18 confirm that these specific issues have not been fully addressed by 19 recent federal or other audits. If these issues have been fully

addressed by other audits, the legislative budget committee shall 1 2 report on the findings of these audits. If these issues have not been fully addressed by other audits, the legislative budget committee shall 3 4 conduct the examination described in subsection (1) of this section. 5 (3) The legislative budget committee shall report the results of 6

their findings and any recommendations to the legislature by January 1, 1994.
