- 1 AN ACT Relating to skill centers; and adding a new chapter to Title
- 2 28C RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** As retraining becomes a common part of an
- 5 individual's work life, it is important that all vocational education
  - opportunities be used to the maximum extent possible. Skill centers
- 7 established to provide vocational training for high school students are
- 8 used during the morning and early afternoon. These facilities are idle
- 9 during the late afternoon and evening hours. To assure that we meet
- 10 the needs of our citizens in seeking training or retraining, all
- 11 vocational training facilities should be used to the maximum extent
- 12 possible.

- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** High school age students shall be allowed to
- 14 enroll in skill centers in the late afternoon and early evening.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Community and technical college students
- 16 served at skill centers as a result of agreements pursuant to RCW
- 17 28B.50.530 may be charged other than the tuition and fees set forth in

- 1 chapter 28B.15 RCW. The enrollments generated pursuant to these
- 2 agreements with skill centers may be in excess of the official
- 3 enrollment level of the college district for state funding purposes.
- 4 The state board for community and technical colleges shall establish by
- 5 rule the manner and means by which the fees to be charged these
- 6 students shall be determined.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The office of the superintendent of public
- 8 instruction shall administer, subject to available funding, two skill
- 9 center pilot programs designed to increase skill center course
- 10 offerings in the late afternoon and evening. The two projects shall be
- 11 geographically dispersed. The work force training and education
- 12 coordinating board is encouraged to provide funding for the pilot
- 13 projects.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 through 4 of this act shall
- 15 constitute a new chapter in Title 28C RCW.
