- 1 AN ACT Relating to higher education; and adding new sections to
- 2 chapter 28B.50 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 For the purposes of determining eligibility of state-funded
- 7 benefits for part-time academic employees in community and technical
- 8 colleges, the following definitions shall be used:
- 9 (1) "Full-time academic work load" means the number of in-class
- 10 teaching hours that will place an academic employee on the full-time
- 11 salary schedule in a given discipline in a given college.
- 12 (a) If full-time academic work load is defined in a contract
- 13 adopted through the collective bargaining process, that definition
- 14 shall prevail.
- 15 (b) If full-time academic work load is not defined in a contract
- 16 adopted through the collective bargaining process, then a full-time
- 17 academic work load means the in-class teaching hours that are necessary
- 18 to place an academic employee on the full-time salary scale in the same
- 19 or a similar discipline at a college that has defined a full-time

- 1 academic work load for academic employees in the same or a similar 2 discipline.
- 3 (2) "In-class teaching hours" means contact classroom and lab hours
 4 in which full or part-time academic employees are performing
 5 contractually assigned teaching duties. The in-class teaching hours
 6 shall not include any duties performed in support of, or in addition to
 7 those contractually assigned in-class teaching hours.
- 8 (3) "Academic employee" means any teacher, counselor, librarian, or 9 department head who is employed by a college district, whether full or 10 part-time, with the exception of the chief administrative officer of, 11 and any administrator in, each college district.
- 12 (4) "Part-time academic work load" means any percentage of a full-13 time academic work load for which the part-time academic employee is 14 not paid on the full-time academic salary schedule.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50 RCW to read as follows:
- For the purposes of determining eligibility for receipt of state-18 funded benefits for part-time academic employees at community and 19 technical colleges, the hours worked by part-time academic employees 20 shall be reported by each institution as a pro rata percentage of the 21 academic work load for full-time academic employees in a given 22 discipline in a given institution.
