- 1 AN ACT Relating to bid limitations for cities and towns; and
- 2 creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A joint select committee on city and town
- 5 bid limitations is created to be composed of six members, three of whom
- 6 are members of the house of representatives appointed by the chief
- 7 clerk of the house of representatives, with no more than two members
- 8 being of the same party, and three of whom are members of the senate
- 9 appointed by the secretary of the senate, with no more than two members
- 10 being of the same party.
- 11 The committee on city and town bid limitations shall review laws
- 12 relating to day labor limits and bidding requirements for cities and
- 13 towns and on or before December 31, 1993, shall prepare a report to the
- 14 legislature on these laws together with any needed legislation altering
- 15 these laws.
- The committee expires on December 31, 1993.
