- AN ACT Relating to correction of the model toxics control act to confirm the availability of a private right of action or right of
- 3 contribution; adding a new section to chapter 70.105D RCW; creating a
- 4 new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.105D 7 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 Except as provided in RCW 70.105D.040(4)(d), a person may bring a
- 9 private right of action, including a claim for contribution or for
- 10 declaratory relief, against another person liable under RCW 70.105D.040
- 11 for the recovery of remedial action costs. Natural resource damages
- 12 paid to the state under this chapter may also be recovered in the
- 13 action. Recovery shall be based on such equitable factors as the court
- 14 determines are appropriate and shall include the prevailing party's
- 15 reasonable attorneys' fees. Recovery of remedial action costs shall be
- 16 limited to those remedial actions that, when evaluated as a whole, are
- 17 the substantial equivalent of a department-conducted or department-
- 18 supervised remedial action. Substantial equivalence shall be
- 19 determined by the court with reference to the rules adopted by the

- 1 department under this chapter. An action under this section may be
- 2 brought after remedial action costs are incurred but must be brought
- 3 within three years from the date remedial action confirms cleanup
- 4 standards are met or within one year of the effective date of this
- 5 section, whichever is later.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act applies to all causes of action
- 7 regardless of when the cause of action may have arisen. To the extent
- 8 a cause of action has arisen prior to the effective date of this act,
- 9 this act applies retroactively, but in all other respects it applies
- 10 prospectively.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 13 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 14 effect immediately.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** If any provision of this act or its
- 16 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 17 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 18 persons or circumstances is not affected.
