- 9 <u>districts</u> to help enlarge the pool of qualified high school students
- 10 who are motivated to become teachers.
- 11 (2) Subject to funds being appropriated, the ((superintendent of public instruction)) professional development centers shall:
- 13 (a) Promote and replicate the teachers recruiting future teachers 14 model program; and
- 15 (b) ((Promote and expand the annual education week program on the
- 16 campus of Central Washington University or on the campuses of other
- 17 interested state institutions of higher education)) Place special
- 18 emphasis on the recruitment of future teachers who are representative
