- 1 AN ACT Relating to early retirement; and amending RCW 41.26.430,
- 2 41.32.765, and 41.40.630.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.26.430 and 1991 c 343 s 18 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member with at least five service 7 credit years of service who has attained at least age fifty-eight shall
- 8 be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed
- 9 according to the provisions of RCW 41.26.420.
- 10 (2) EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least twenty
- 11 service credit years of service and has attained age fifty shall be
- 12 eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed
- 13 according to the provisions of RCW 41.26.420, except that a member
- 14 retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement
- 15 allowance ((actuarially)) reduced one percent per year to reflect the
- 16 difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the
- 17 attainment of age fifty-eight.

- 1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 41.32.765 and 1991 c 343 s 5 are each amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member with at least five service 4 credit years of service who has attained at least age sixty-five shall 5 be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed 6 according to the provisions of RCW 41.32.760.
- 7 (2) EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least twenty 8 service credit years of service who has attained at least age fifty-9 five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance 10 computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.32.760, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement 11 allowance ((actuarially)) reduced one percent per year to reflect the 12 13 difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five. 14
- 15 **Sec. 3.** RCW 41.40.630 and 1991 c 343 s 11 are each amended to read 16 as follows:
- 17 (1) NORMAL RETIREMENT. Any member with at least five service 18 credit years who has attained at least age sixty-five shall be eligible 19 to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to 20 the provisions of RCW 41.40.620.
 - (2) EARLY RETIREMENT. Any member who has completed at least twenty service credit years and has attained age fifty-five shall be eligible to retire and to receive a retirement allowance computed according to the provisions of RCW 41.40.620, except that a member retiring pursuant to this subsection shall have the retirement allowance ((actuarially)) reduced one percent per year to reflect the difference in the number of years between age at retirement and the attainment of age sixty-five.
