- AN ACT Relating to therapeutic child care; amending RCW 74.14C.070
- 2 and 74.14B.040; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. The legislature finds that Sec. 1. 5 preservation services and therapeutic child care strengthen at-risk These services are successful at preventing a child's 6 removal from the family home and resolving behaviors that have the potential to harm children. Providing administrative agencies with the 8 9 flexibility to transfer funds to prevention programs will reduce out-10 of-home placement of children, keep families together, and save the state money through avoided expenditures for foster care. 11
- 12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 74.14C.070 and 1992 c 214 s 9 are each amended to read 13 as follows:
- 14 After July 1, 1993, the secretary of social and health services may 15 transfer funds appropriated for foster care services to purchase family 16 preservation services, or therapeutic child care, for children at 17 imminent risk of foster care placement. The secretary shall notify the 18 appropriate committees of the senate and house of representatives of

- 2 caseload, expenditure, cost avoidance, identified improvements to the
- 3 foster care system, and outcome data related to the transfer in the
- 4 notification.
- 5 **Sec. 3.** RCW 74.14B.040 and 1987 c 503 s 13 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 The department shall, within funds appropriated for this purpose,
- 8 provide therapeutic ((day)) child care and day treatment to children
- 9 who have been abused or neglected and meet program eligibility
- 10 criteria.
