- offices of the auditor's office at which any registered voter of the

11 12 Absentee ballot voting by personal appearance may be conducted at such a satellite office not earlier than the twentieth day before the primary or special or general election and not later than the day before the primary or election. The hours and days during which a satellite office is operated in that period shall be established by the auditor.
