- 1 AN ACT Relating to public health; adding new sections to chapter
- 2 43.20A; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that many homeless
- 5 people in the state of Washington have impaired eyesight that reduces
 - their chances of obtaining employment or training for employment. The
- 7 legislature finds that it is in the public interest to facilitate
- 8 ophthalmologists and opticians in providing free vision services to
- 9 homeless people of the state.

- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The secretary of the department of social
- 11 and health services shall coordinate the efforts of nonprofit agencies
- 12 working with the homeless, the Washington academy of eye physicians and
- 13 surgeons, and the opticians association of Washington to deliver vision
- 14 services to the homeless free of charge. The secretary shall enter
- 15 into agreements identifying cooperating agencies and the circumstances
- 16 under which specified services will be delivered.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** To the extent consistent with the
- 2 department's budget, the secretary shall pay for the eyeglasses
- 3 hardware prescribed and dispensed pursuant to the program set up in
- 4 sections 2 through 6 of this act. The secretary shall also attempt to
- 5 obtain private sector funding for this program.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Ophthalmologists and dispensing opticians
- 7 may utilize used eyeglass frames obtained through donations to this
- 8 program.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** An ophthalmologist or dispensing optician
- 10 who provides:
- 11 (1) Free vision services; or
- 12 (2) Eyeglasses, or any part thereof, including used frames, at or
- 13 below retail cost to homeless people in the state of Washington
- 14 shall be immune from all civil or administrative processes except for
- 15 malicious conduct clearly intended to harm these persons.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** Nothing in sections 2 through 6 of this act
- 17 shall prevent ophthalmologists or dispensing opticians from collecting
- 18 for either their goods or services, or both from third-party payers
- 19 covering the goods or services for homeless persons.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** The program created in sections 2 through 6
- 21 of this act shall be known as the eye care for the homeless program in
- 22 Washington.
- 23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** Sections 2 through 7 of this act are each
- 24 added to chapter 43.20A RCW.
