- 1 AN ACT Relating to foster parents; adding a new section to chapter
- 2 74.13 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that foster parents are often required to spend their own money on the care and treatment
- 6 of foster children because the department of social and health services
- 7 reimburses foster parents retrospectively for expenses incurred. This
- 8 places an additional burden on foster parents who are currently
- 9 experiencing more difficult children for placement, low reimbursement
- 10 rates, and demands for increased training and service outcomes.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 74.13 RCW
- 12 under the subchapter heading "Foster Care" to read as follows:
- 13 The department of social and health services shall develop a system
- 14 for providing foster parents with prospective reimbursement for
- 15 expenses incurred related to the care and treatment of foster children.

- 1 The department may issue credit cards, use electronic benefit transfer
- 2 technology, or other methods to address this problem.
