- 1 AN ACT Relating to a merger of the departments of fisheries and 2 wildlife; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. The legislature finds that there are NEW SECTION. 5 inefficiencies in the current system of fish and wildlife management in 6 the state. Salmon, shellfish, and marine fish management are under the jurisdiction of the department of fisheries, and steelhead trout and 8 resident fish and wildlife management are under the jurisdiction of the 9 department of wildlife. This separation results in duplication of 10 effort, confusion for the public, conflicting missions regarding the state's fish and wildlife resources, and other inefficiencies. 11
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** On or before January 1, 1997, the department of fisheries, the department of wildlife, and the fish and wildlife commission shall merge to form a department of fish and wildlife.
- The departments shall consult with the commission, the legislative budget committee, and the office of financial management to determine the most cost-effective and efficient process for achieving the merger.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. On or before January 1, 1995, the departments shall present to the appropriate legislative committees
- 3 recommended legislation encompassing all of the statutory changes
- 4 necessary to complete the merger.
