- AN ACT Relating to procedures for out-of-state travel by agencies;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 41.04 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The highest-ranking official in an agency shall authorize in 7 writing travel taken for the agency:
- 8 (a) Internationally; or
- 9 (b) If two or more appointive officials or employees of the agency 10 are going to the same out-of-state location or event.
- 11 (2) The highest-ranking official in an agency shall make a separate 12 authorization for each trip taken under this section.
- 13 (3) The highest-ranking official in an agency may not delegate the 14 duties imposed under this section unless the official has delegated all
- 15 management responsibilities because of a long-term absence such as a
- 16 vacation.
- 17 (4) For the purposes of this section, the following definitions
- 18 apply:

- 1 (a) "Agency" means any commission, agency, or other body of the 2 executive, judicial, or legislative branches of state government.
- 3 (b) "The highest-ranking official" means the head of an agency or, 4 for the head of an agency, the governor.
