- 1 AN ACT Relating to the recovery of costs for expanded calling areas
- 2 for local exchange companies; adding a new section to chapter 80.36
- 3 RCW; creating a new section; and repealing RCW 80.36.850, 80.36.855,
- 4 and 80.36.860.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature declares that it is the
- 7 policy of the state to ensure reasonable and affordable local calling
- 8 areas that provide citizens with the ability to reach basic business,
- 9 government, and human services. Therefore, the legislature finds that
- 10 it is in the public interest to establish a state-wide community
- 11 calling fund to effect the transition to expanded calling areas.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 80.36 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (1) In ordering the expansion of local calling area routes, the
- 15 commission shall provide for the recovery of the associated costs,
- 16 including but not limited to lost toll or access revenue, engineering
- 17 costs, and construction costs, in a manner that produces fair, just,
- 18 and reasonable rates. In providing for the recovery of costs under

- $1\,$  this section, the commission may impose a charge on all switched access
- 2 lines provided by local exchange companies in this state, not to exceed
- 3 ten cents per line per month, and order multicompany pooling of the
- 4 charges collected.
- 5 (2) The commission may by rule establish procedures to calculate
- 6 and assess a charge imposed on access lines under subsection (1) of
- 7 this section, and to order the distribution of funds pooled from the
- 8 charges, provided that no funds shall be distributed to a local
- 9 exchange company that serves more than fifteen thousand access lines.
- 10 (3) The commission shall review this program and shall provide the
- 11 legislature by January 1, 1998, with a report on the effect terminating
- 12 the program would have on local telephone rates.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The following acts or parts of acts are each
- 14 repealed:
- 15 (1) RCW 80.36.850 and 1989 c 282 s 2;
- 16 (2) RCW 80.36.855 and 1989 c 282 s 3; and
- 17 (3) RCW 80.36.860 and 1989 c 282 s 6.
