- 1 AN ACT Relating to pollution prevention; and adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 70.95C RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.95C RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Not later than January 1, 1994, the department shall designate
- 7 an industry type and up to ten individual facilities within that
- 8 industry type to be the focus of a pilot multimedia program. The
- 9 program shall be designed to coordinate department actions related to
- 10 environmental permits, plans, approvals, certificates, registrations,
- 11 technical assistance, and inspections. The program shall also
- 12 investigate the feasibility of issuing facility-wide permits. The
- 13 department shall determine the industry type and facilities based on
- 14 criteria which shall include at least the following factors:
- 15 (a) The potential for the industry to serve as a state-wide model
- 16 for multimedia environmental programs including pollution prevention;
- 17 (b) The existence within the industry type of a range of business
- 18 sizes; and
- 19 (c) Voluntary participation in the program.

- 1 (2) Not later than January 1, 1996, the department shall submit to 2 the governor and the appropriate standing committees of the 3 legislature:
- 4 (a) A report evaluating the pilot multimedia program. The report 5 shall consider the program's effect on the efficiency and effectiveness 6 of program delivery and shall evaluate the feasibility of expanding the 7 program to other industry types; and
- 8 (b) A report analyzing the feasibility of a facility-wide permit 9 program.
- 10 (3) In developing the program, the department shall consult with 11 and seek the cooperation of the environmental protection agency.
- (4) For purposes of this section, "facility-wide permit" means a single multimedia permit issued by the department to the owner or operator of a facility incorporating the permits and any other relevant department approvals previously issued to the owner or operator or currently required by the department.
