1 AN ACT Relating to state remembrances; and amending RCW 1.20.010.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 1.20.010 and 1967 ex.s. c 65 s 2 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 The official flag of the state of Washington shall be of dark green
6 silk or bunting and shall bear in its center ~~((a))~~ an embroidered,
7 printed, painted, or stamped reproduction of the seal of the state of
8 Washington ~~((embroidered, printed, painted or stamped thereon))~~. The
9 edges of the flag may ~~((, or may not,))~~ be fringed. If a fringe is used
10 ~~((the same)),~~ it shall be ~~((of))~~ a gold or yellow color of the same
11 shade as the seal. The dimensions of the flag may vary.

12 The secretary of state is authorized, in his or her discretion, to
13 provide the state flag without charge:

14 (1) To units of the armed forces~~((, without charge therefor, as in~~
15 ~~his discretion he deems entitled thereto))~~;

16 (2) In memory of a state employee killed in the performance of his
17 or her duties for the state;

18 (3) In memory of a current or former elected or appointed state
19 official upon the death of that person; or

1 (4) To a citizen who has performed outstanding service for the
2 benefit of the state.

3 The secretary of state is also authorized to seek private funds to
4 pay for state flags given under this section and for other appropriate
5 gifts, tokens of appreciation, mementos of Washington state, and
6 related costs for visiting state, national, and international guests.

7 The secretary of state is further authorized to sell the state flag
8 to any citizen at a price to be determined by the secretary of state.
