- 1 AN ACT Relating to hazardous waste disposal facilities; and adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 70.105 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.105 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) In addition to other financial responsibility requirements, the 7 department shall require a hazardous waste disposal facility with a
- 8 permitted handling capacity to incinerate five thousand or more tons of
- 9 hazardous wastes or hazardous substances to maintain financial
- 10 responsibility in the amount of at least twenty-five million dollars to
- 11 compensate for personal injury or damages to property that may result
- 12 from discharges or emissions from the facility.
- 13 (2) If a facility fails to maintain financial responsibility
- 14 required by this section, the department shall immediately suspend the
- 15 facility's permit to operate until the required financial
- 16 responsibility is established to the satisfaction of the department.
- 17 (3) Proof of financial responsibility required under this section 18 may be given by filing:
- 19 (a) A certificate of insurance;

- 1 (b) A bond; or
- 2 (c) A certificate of deposit of money or securities.
- 3 (4) The department may adopt rules to implement this section.
