- 2 chapter 44.04 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Each person elected or appointed to the office of a member of the
- 7 state legislature shall take and subscribe to an oath of office upon
- 8 first assuming office for any elective or appointed term for the
- 9 office. The oath shall be substantially as follows: "I do solemnly
- 10 swear (or affirm) that I will support the Constitution of the United
- 11 States of America and the Constitution and laws of the state of
- 12 Washington, and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of the
- 13 office entrusted to me to the best of my ability." A copy of the oath
- 14 shall be filed with the secretary of state.
