## HOUSE BILL 1886

- AN ACT Relating to authorizing the board of boiler rules to prescribe extended inspection schedules for power boilers; and amending RCW 70.79.240, 70.79.250, and 70.79.260.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.79.240 and 1951 c 32 s 22 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- Each boiler and unfired pressure vessel used or proposed to be used within this state, except boilers or unfired pressure vessels exempt in RCW 70.79.080 and 70.79.090, shall be thoroughly inspected as to their
- 10 construction, installation, condition and operation, as follows:
- 11 (1) Power boilers shall be inspected annually both internally and
- 12 externally while not under pressure, except that the board may, in its
- 13 <u>discretion</u>, <u>provide for longer periods between inspections</u> and shall
- 14 also be inspected annually externally while under pressure if possible;
- 15 (2) Low pressure heating boilers shall be inspected both internally 16 and externally biennially where construction will permit;
- 17 (3) Unfired pressure vessels subject to internal corrosion shall be 18 inspected both internally and externally biennially where construction

- will permit, except that the board may, in its discretion, provide for
  longer periods between inspections;
- 3 (4) Unfired pressure vessels not subject to internal corrosion 4 shall be inspected externally at intervals set by the board, but internal inspections shall not be required of unfired pressure vessels, 5 the contents of which are known to be noncorrosive to the material of 6 7 which the shell, head, or fittings are constructed, either from the 8 chemical composition of the contents or from evidence that the contents 9 are adequately treated with a corrosion inhibitor, provided that such 10 vessels are constructed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the board or in accordance with standards substantially equivalent to 11 the rules and regulations of the board, in effect at the time of 12 13 manufacture.
- 14 **Sec. 2.** RCW 70.79.250 and 1951 c 32 s 23 are each amended to read 15 as follows:
- 16 In the case of power boilers a grace period of not more than two months longer than the ((twelve months may)) period between inspections 17 18 prescribed by the board shall elapse between internal inspections of a 19 boiler while not under pressure or between external inspections of a boiler while under pressure; in the case of low pressure heating 20 boilers not more than twenty-six months shall elapse between 21 inspections, and in the case of unfired pressure vessels not more than 22 23 two months longer than the period between inspections prescribed by the 24 board shall elapse between internal inspections.
- 25 **Sec. 3.** RCW 70.79.260 and 1951 c 32 s 24 are each amended to read 26 as follows:
- The rules and regulations formulated by the board applying to the inspection of <u>boilers and</u> unfired pressure vessels may ((<del>be modified by the board to</del>)) reduce or extend the interval between required inspections where the contents, <u>history</u>, or operation of the <u>boiler or</u> vessel or the material of which it is constructed warrant special consideration.
