- 1 AN ACT Relating to sexual intercourse or contact with dead bodies;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 9A.44 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Any person who has sexual intercourse or sexual contact with a dead human body is guilty of a class C felony.
- (2) As used in this section: 8
- 9 (a) "Sexual intercourse" (i) has its ordinary meaning and occurs 10 upon any penetration, however slight; and (ii) also means any 11 penetration of the vagina or anus however slight, by an object, when 12 committed on a dead human body, except when such penetration is 13 accomplished as part of a procedure authorized or required under 14 chapter 68.50 RCW or other law; and (iii) also means any act of sexual
- 15 contact between the sex organs of a person and the mouth or anus of a
- dead human body. 16

1 (b) "Sexual contact" means any touching by a person of the sexual 2 or other intimate parts of a dead human body done for the purpose of 3 gratifying the sexual desire of the person.
