- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.150 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Any volunteer, including a volunteer organization, may assist a
- 7 public agency, with the agency's approval, in a collaborative program
- 8 for serving the needs of at-risk youth as defined by RCW 13.32A.030(5).
- 9 Such programs shall be established in accordance with guidelines issued
- 10 by the center for volunteerism and citizen service defining reasonable
- 11 safety standards to protect the safety of program participants and
- 12 volunteers. In carrying out the volunteer activity, the volunteer
- 13 shall not be considered an employee or agent of the public agency
- 14 administering the collaborative program. A volunteer who has complied
- 15 with these reasonable safety standards shall be presumed to be acting
- 16 in good faith. To recover damages, a claimant must establish by a
- 17 preponderance of the evidence that a public agency or other sponsor of
