- 1 AN ACT Relating to social security numbers used as student
- 2 identification; adding a new section to chapter 28A.600 RCW; creating
- 3 a new section; and making an appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.600 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Beginning in the 1993-94 school year, each school district
- 8 shall request that each student enrolled in a public school in this
- 9 state provide his or her social security number.
- 10 (2) Beginning in the 1994-95 school year, each school district
- 11 shall use social security numbers as student identification numbers in
- 12 the management information system used by the school district.
- 13 (3) A student may satisfy the requirement to provide his or her
- 14 social security number by presenting his or her social security card or
- 15 a copy of the card. A student is not required to provide his or her
- 16 social security number and shall not be denied any right, benefit, or
- 17 privilege for refusing to disclose his or her social security number.
- 18 (4) The school district shall include the social security number in
- 19 the student's permanent record or indicate if the student

- 1 identification number is not a social security number. The
- 2 superintendent of public instruction shall provide assistance to school
- 3 districts to assure that the assignment of student identification
- 4 numbers other than social security numbers is kept to a minimum and to
- 5 avoid duplication of a student identification number.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** By March 1, 1994, the superintendent of
- 7 public instruction shall report to the state board of education the
- 8 increase in student social security numbers on record and actions
- 9 implemented and planned to enable school districts to comply with
- 10 section 1 of this act by the 1994-95 school year.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The sum of dollars, or as much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending
- 13 June 30, 1995, from the general fund to the office of the
- 14 superintendent of public instruction for the purposes of this act.
