- 1 AN ACT Relating to construction standards for temporary worker
- 2 housing; creating a new section; and repealing RCW 19.27.078.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The state building code council shall
- 5 conduct a study on methods to reduce the cost of rehabilitation or new
 - construction of buildings and structures used as temporary worker
- 7 housing. In conducting the study, the council shall recommend what
- 8 requirements under RCW 19.27.031, as adopted and amended by the state
- 9 building code council, can be reduced for temporary worker housing
- 10 while still meeting the health, safety, and welfare of the occupants of
- 11 the building or structure. The findings of the study shall be
- 12 submitted in a written report to the appropriate legislative committees
- 13 of the house of representatives and the senate no later than December
- 14 1, 1993.

- 15 (2) The study required under this section shall consider, but not
- 16 be limited to: The period of the year when the temporary worker
- 17 housing is expected to be occupied; the requirements needed to convert
- 18 the temporary worker housing into housing that is occupied on a year

- 1 round basis; and rules or regulations adopted by other states on 2 temporary worker housing.
- 3 (3) As used in this section, "temporary worker housing" means a 4 dwelling unit that is occupied by a person or household for less than 5 six months of the year and is provided as a condition of employment.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** RCW 19.27.078 and 1989 c 266 s 4 & 1985 c 7 360 s 3 are each repealed.
