- 1 AN ACT Relating to notice about fetal alcohol syndrome; adding a
- 2 new section to chapter 66.08 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The United States surgeon general warns that
- 5 women should not drink alcoholic beverages during pregnancy because of
- 6 the risk of birth defects. The legislature finds that these defects
- 7 include fetal alcohol syndrome, a birth defect that causes permanent
- 8 antisocial behavior in the sufferer, disrupts the functions of his or
- 9 her family, and, at an alarmingly increasing rate, extracts a safety
- 10 and fiscal toll on society.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 66.08 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 The board shall cause to be posted in a conspicuous place within
- 14 each state liquor store a notice warning women that drinking alcohol
- 15 during pregnancy can cause birth defects, including fetal alcohol
- 16 syndrome and fetal alcohol effects.
