- 1 AN ACT Relating to the maintenance and efficient operation of state
- 2 agency and school district facilities; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the capital stock
- 5 of facilities owned by state agencies represents a significant
- 6 financial investment by the citizens of the state of Washington and
- 7 that adequate maintenance is critical to preserving these facilities
- 8 and realizing the full value of this investment.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Each state agency that owns and manages
- 10 capital facilities shall include in its capital budget request for the
- 11 1995-1997 biennium a description of its facility maintenance and
- 12 management program. The office of financial management shall develop
- 13 definitions and guidelines for the submission of, at a minimum, the
- 14 following information by each agency: A description of the agency's
- 15 current facility maintenance and management program; a description of
- 16 the maintenance requirements of the agency's facilities, including
- 17 deferred maintenance; a description of any active or planned corrective
- 18 or preventive maintenance program; and an estimate of staffing and

- 1 budgetary resources associated with its facility maintenance and
- 2 management program.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The office of financial management shall convene a study group to evaluate the information submitted under 4 section 2 of this act and recommend ways to improve agency facility 5 maintenance and management programs. The study group shall include 6 7 representatives of state agencies, including institutions of higher 8 education, with maintenance expertise or budget responsibility. office of financial management shall report on the findings and 9 recommendations of the study group to the appropriate fiscal committees 10 of the legislature by December 1, 1995. 11
