- 3 and adding a new section to chapter 35.21 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- This chapter shall not apply to a newspaper carrier under eighteen
- 8 years of age.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 35.21 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 A city or town, including a code city, may not license newspaper
- 12 carriers under eighteen years of age for either regulatory or revenue-
- 13 generating purposes.
