1 AN ACT Relating to funding for state patrol criminal justice
2 activities; amending RCW 43.08.250; providing an effective date; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.08.250 and 1992 c 54 s 3 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 The money received by the state treasurer from fees, fines,
8 forfeitures, penalties, reimbursements or assessments by any court
9 organized under Title 3 or 35 RCW, or chapter 2.08 RCW, shall be
10 deposited in the public safety and education account which is hereby
11 created in the state treasury. The legislature shall appropriate the
12 funds in the account to promote traffic safety education, highway
13 safety, criminal justice training, crime victims' compensation,
14 judicial education, the judicial information system, civil
15 representation of indigent persons, winter recreation parking, ((and))
16 state game programs(~~(. During the fiscal biennium ending June 30,~~
17 ~~1993, the legislature may appropriate moneys from the public safety and~~
18 ~~education account)), state patrol criminal justice activities including
19 but not limited to fingerprinting, identification, and crime lab~~

1 activities, and for the purposes of local jail population data
2 collection under RCW 10.98.130(~~(, the department of corrections' county~~
3 ~~partnership program under RCW 72.09.300, the treatment alternatives to~~
4 ~~street crimes program, the criminal litigation unit of the attorney~~
5 ~~general's office, and contracts with county officials to provide~~
6 ~~support enforcement services))~~).

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
9 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
10 effect July 1, 1993.
