- 1 AN ACT Relating to time in the state of Washington; amending RCW
- 2 1.20.050; repealing RCW 1.20.051; and providing an effective date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 1.20.050 and 1953 c 2 s 1 are each amended to read as 5 follows:
- 6 (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) of this section,
  7 the time of the state of Washington is Pacific standard time.
- 8 (2) No county, city or other political subdivision of this state 9 shall adopt any provision for the observance of ((daylight saving time, 10 or)) any time other than <u>Pacific</u> standard <u>time</u>, except pursuant to a 11 gubernatorial proclamation declaring an emergency during a period of 12 national war and <u>setting such other time for the state or</u> authorizing
- 13 such adoption((<del>, or unless other than standard time is established on</del>
- 14 a national basis: PROVIDED, That)) by a unit of local government.
- 15 <u>(3) This section shall not apply to orders made by federal</u> 16 authorities in a local area entirely under federal control.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. RCW 1.20.051 and 1963 c 14 s 1 & 1961 c 3 s 1 are each repealed.
