1 AN ACT Relating to residential habilitation centers; amending RCW  
2 71A.20.020; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 71A.20.020 and 1988 c 176 s 702 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 The following residential habilitation centers are permanently  
7 established to provide services to persons with developmental  
8 disabilities: (~~Interlake School, located at Medical Lake, Spokane~~  
9 ~~county~~) Lakeland Village, located at Medical Lake, Spokane county;  
10 Rainier School, located at Buckley, Pierce county; Yakima Valley  
11 School, located at Selah, Yakima county; Fircrest School, located at  
12 Seattle, King county; and Frances Haddon Morgan Children's Center,  
13 located at Bremerton, Kitsap county.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The legislature shall consider the amendment  
15 or repeal of RCW 71A.20.020 following the submission of the report by  
16 the secretary of the department of social and health services required  
17 by chapter . . . . (House Bill No. 2163), Laws of 1994.

1        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 3.**    This act is necessary for the immediate  
2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
3 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
4 effect immediately.
