- 1 AN ACT Relating to temporary housing for homeless, unaccompanied
- 2 youth; adding a new section to chapter 43.185 RCW; creating a new

State of Washington

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that homeless,
- 6 unaccompanied youth have essential needs that must be addressed if they
- 7 are to be successfully reunited with their families or transitioned
- 8 into independent living. The legislature further finds that one of
- 9 these essential needs is safe housing.
- 10 (2) It is the intent of the legislature to facilitate the
- 11 establishment and operation of temporary shelters for homeless,
- 12 unaccompanied youth in which these youth can be housed safely and
- 13 obtain appropriate supportive services.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.185 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 43.185.070, for the
- 17 period beginning July 1, 1994, through June 30, 1995, the department

- 1 shall give preference to applications for projects that provide 2 temporary housing for homeless, unaccompanied youth.
- 3 (2) Projects funded under this section shall provide assurances
- 4 that the facility is maintained in compliance with applicable licensing
- 5 and state and local building and safety codes.
- 6 (3) This section shall expire July 1, 1995.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 9 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 10 effect immediately.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** If any provision of this act or its
- 12 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 13 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 14 persons or circumstances is not affected.
