- 1 AN ACT Relating to siting of adult detention facilities; adding a

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.65 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The department may not establish or relocate an adult detention
- 7 facility in a new location that is closer than two miles from a school,
- 8 day care center, or a facility whose primary service clients are
- 9 children, developmentally disabled adults, or other individuals deemed
- 10 vulnerable by the director, such as the aged or infirm.
- 11 (2) The department may not establish or relocate an adult detention
- 12 facility in a new location until after the department holds a minimum
- 13 of two public hearings.
- 14 (3) The department of community, trade, and economic development
- 15 shall establish procedures providing for early and continuous public
- 16 participation in the development of adult detention facility placement
- 17 plans. The procedures must provide, with particular emphasis on the
- 18 communities surrounding the proposed siting, for broad dissemination of
- 19 proposals and alternatives, opportunity for written comments, public

- 1 meetings after effective notice, provision for open discussion,
- 2 communication programs, information services, and consideration of and

- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its
- 5 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 6 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 7 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1994.
