- 1 AN ACT Relating to courts; and adding a new section to chapter
- 2 36.18 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 36.18 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Superior court clerks may contract with collection agencies or may
- 7 use county collection services for the collection of unpaid court
- 8 obligations. Collection may not be initiated with respect to a
- 9 criminal offender who is under the supervision of the department of
- 10 corrections without the prior agreement of the department.
- 11 Any contract with a collection agency shall be awarded only after
- 12 competitive bidding. Factors that a court clerk shall consider in
- 13 awarding a collection contract include but are not limited to: (1) A
- 14 collection agency's history and reputation in the community; and (2)
- 15 the agency's access to a local data base that may increase the
- 16 efficiency of its collections.

The servicing of an unpaid court obligation does not constitute assignment of a debt, and no contract with a collection agency may remove the court's control over unpaid obligations owed to the court.
