The legislature finds that local governments and private waste management companies have significantly changed solid waste management practices in an effort to preserve landfill space and to avoid costly environmental cleanups of municipal landfills. The legislature recognizes the efforts of local governments and the waste management industry for helping the state to achieve one of the
- The legislature also finds that solid waste rates have increased substantially in order to pay for the cleanup of past disposal practices and new recycling services that preserve landfill space and avoid future cleanup costs. The legislature further finds that citymanaged collection systems are required to notify private collection companies of rate changes but are not required to notify the public.
