- 12 habitual drunkard, or of unsound mind.

- 15 No ((minor)) person under the age of ((fourteen)) eighteen years
- 16 ((shall)) may handle or have in his or her possession or under his or

approved for the purpose of this section by the parent or guardian, (2) 1 while at his or her residence, with the permission of his or her parent 2 or legal guardian, for the purpose of exercising the rights specified 3 4 in RCW 9A.16.020(3), (3) while hunting with a valid hunting license, using a rifle or shotgun, (4) while at a recognized competitive 5 shooting event at an established gun range, or (5) while under the 6 immediate supervision of a ((certified)) safety instructor at an 7 8 established gun range or firearm training class((, any firearm of any 9 kind for hunting or target practice or for other purposes. Every person violating any of the foregoing provisions, or aiding or 10 knowingly permitting any such minor to violate the same, shall be 11 guilty of a misdemeanor)). "Immediate supervision" means one-to-one 12 supervision when the person under the age of eighteen is engaged in 13 14 live fire training. A person violating this section, or aiding or knowingly permitting a person under the age of eighteen years to 15 violate this section, is guilty of a class C felony. 16
