- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The regulation of immigration assistants is
- 5 a matter affecting the public interest for the purpose of applying
 - chapter 19.86 RCW. Activities of immigration assistants prohibited
- 7 under this chapter are not reasonable in relation to the development
- 8 and preservation of business. A violation of this chapter constitutes
- 9 an unfair or deceptive act or practice in trade or commerce for the
- 10 purposes of applying the consumer protection act, chapter 19.86 RCW.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Individuals practicing under this chapter
- 12 are required to possess a surety bond in the amount of ten thousand
- 13 dollars, and errors and omissions malpractice insurance in the amount
- 14 of at least one hundred thousand dollars.
