- 1 AN ACT Relating to the enforcement of state law by a federal
- 2 officer; and adding a new chapter to Title 10 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Unless the context clearly requires
- 5 otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this
- 6 chapter.
- 7 (1) "Arrest" means to place a person under actual or constructive
- 8 restraint or to take a person into custody for the purpose of charging
- 9 that person with an offense.
- 10 (2) "Federal officer" means a special agent or law enforcement
- 11 officer employed by a federal agency and who is empowered to effect an
- 12 arrest with or without a warrant for violations of the United States
- 13 Code and who is authorized to carry firearms in the performance of
- 14 duty.
- 15 (3) "Peace officer" means a duly appointed city, county, or state
- 16 law enforcement officer.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) A federal officer may effect the
- 18 arrest of a person violating the laws of Washington state:

- 1 (a) When the federal officer has probable cause to believe that a 2 felony or gross misdemeanor has been committed or is being committed;
- 3 (b) When rendering assistance to a peace officer in an emergency 4 situation or at the request of a law enforcement officer; or
- 5 (c) When the federal officer has received positive information, 6 conforming with RCW 10.31.030 and 10.31.060, that a peace officer holds 7 a warrant for the arrest of a person.
- 8 (2) The federal officer shall inform the person to be arrested of 9 the federal officer's authority and reason for the arrest.
- 10 (3) In order to make an arrest a federal officer may use all justifiable physical force which a peace officer is authorized to use 12 under RCW 9A.16.020, 9A.16.040, and 10.31.050.
- 13 (4) A federal officer making an arrest under this section shall 14 take the arrested person before a magistrate or deliver the offender to 15 a peace officer without unnecessary delay.
- 16 (5) A federal officer when making an arrest for a nonfederal 17 offense under this section has the same immunity from suit as a state 18 or local law enforcement officer.
- 19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The Washington state criminal justice 20 training commission may require that a federal officer meet reasonable 21 training or certification standards or other reasonable standards.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. Sections 1 through 3 of this act shall constitute a new chapter in Title 10 RCW.
