- 1 AN ACT Relating to medical care for inmates; and adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 72.10 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.10 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Any health care services plan provided to inmates by the department
- 7 shall require the inmate to be responsible for a nominal payment of
- 8 five dollars per medical encounter, in addition to any other financial
- 9 responsibility the inmate may have for medical care. Any subsequent
- 10 encounters ordered by the attending health care provider directly
- 11 related to the original diagnosis shall not require that an encounter
- 12 fee be charged to the offender. Mental health encounters and medical
- 13 encounters required for the dispensation of prescribed pharmaceuticals
- 14 or for readily apparent injuries or traumas shall not be subject to the
- 15 medical encounter fee. The payment shall be deducted from the personal
- 16 account of the inmate or paid in person. Necessary medical services
