- AN ACT Relating to the Washington council for the prevention of child abuse and neglect; and amending RCW 43.121.020.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.121.020 and 1989 c 304 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) There is established in the executive office of the governor a 7 Washington council for the prevention of child abuse and neglect 8 subject to the jurisdiction of the governor.
- 9 (2) The council shall be composed of the chairperson and twelve 10 other members as follows:
- 11 (a) The chairperson and six other members shall be appointed by the 12 governor and shall be selected for their interest and expertise in the 13 prevention of child abuse. A minimum of four designees by the governor 14 shall not be affiliated with governmental agencies. The appointments 15 shall be made geographic basis assure state-wide on а to 16 representation. Members appointed by the governor shall serve for 17 ((two-year)) three-year terms((, except that the chairperson and two 18 other members designated by the governor shall initially serve for

three years)). Vacancies shall be filled for any unexpired term by appointment in the same manner as the original appointments were made.

- (b) The secretary of social and health services or the secretary's designee and the superintendent of public instruction or the superintendent's designee shall serve as voting members of the council.
- (c) In addition to the members of the council, four members of the legislature shall serve as nonvoting, ex officio members of the council, one from each political caucus of the house of representatives to be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and one from each political caucus of the senate to be appointed by the president of the senate.
