- 1 AN ACT Relating to children in motor vehicles; amending RCW
- 2 46.61.685; and repealing RCW 9.91.060.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.685 and 1990 c 250 s 57 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 It is unlawful for any person, while operating or in charge of a
- 7 vehicle, to park or willfully allow ((such)) the vehicle to stand upon
- 8 a public highway or in a public place with its motor running, leaving
- 9 a minor child or children under the age of sixteen years ((unattended))
- 10 in the vehicle <u>unattended</u> by a person sixteen years of age or older.
- 11 If a child is ten years of age or younger, it is unlawful to leave the
- 12 <u>child in a vehicle unattended by a person sixteen years of age or older</u>
- 13 whether or not the vehicle's motor is running.
- 14 Any person violating the provisions of this section is guilty of a
- 15 misdemeanor. Upon a second or subsequent conviction for a violation of
- 16 this section, the department shall revoke the operator's license of
- 17 ((such)) the person.
