- 1 AN ACT Relating to firearm control; adding new sections to chapter
- 2 9.41 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Except as provided in this section, no person shall store or 7 leave a loaded firearm, or an unloaded firearm accompanied by 8 ammunition, in any location where the person knows, or reasonably 9 should know, that an unsupervised child is likely to gain access.
- 10 (2) This section shall not apply to:

- 11 (a) A firearm which has been secured with a trigger lock or other 12 similar device which prevents the firearm from discharging;
 - (b) A child's access to firearms which is supervised by an adult;
- 14 (c) A child's access to firearms which was obtained as a result of an unlawful entry;
- 16 (d) A child who possesses a valid hunting license issued by the 17 department of fish and wildlife and who successfully completed the 18 department's course of instruction in the safe handling of firearms,
- 19 safety, conservation, and sportsmanship; or

- 1 (e) Law enforcement officers while engaged in their official 2 duties.
- 3 (3) Any person who violates the provisions of this section is 4 guilty of a gross misdemeanor and shall upon conviction be fined not 5 more than five thousand dollars or imprisoned for not more than one 6 year, or both.
 - (4) For the purposes of this section:

- 8 (a) "Ammunition" means any ammunition cartridge, shell, or other 9 device containing explosive or incendiary material designed and 10 intended for use in any firearm.
- 11 (b) "Child" means any person under the age of sixteen years.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW to read as follows:
- 14 (1) When selling any firearm, licensed firearms dealers shall offer 15 to sell or give the purchaser a trigger-locking device.
- (2) At every purchase counter in every store, shop, or sales outlet, licensed firearms dealers shall conspicuously post the following warning in block letters not less than one inch in height:

 "IT IS UNLAWFUL TO STORE OR LEAVE AN UNLOCKED FIREARM WHERE CHILDREN CAN OBTAIN ACCESS."
- 21 (3) Any person who violates the provisions of this section is 22 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction be fined not more 23 than five hundred dollars.
- (4) For the purposes of this section, "trigger-locking device" means a padlock, keylock, combination lock, or similar locking device which, when the device is locked on, around, or in the firearm, renders the firearm incapable of firing.
