- 1 AN ACT Relating to signage concerning alcoholic beverages; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 66.08 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.08 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Licensees under this title shall post notices that warn persons
- 7 that consumption of alcohol shortly before conception or during
- 8 pregnancy may cause birth defects, including fetal alcohol syndrome and
- 9 fetal alcohol effects.
- 10 (2) The notices required under subsection (1) of this section shall
- 11 be posted as follows:
- 12 (a) For establishments licensed to sell spirituous liquor by the
- 13 glass, or beer or wine for consumption on the premises or in a room,
- 14 notice shall be posted at the entrance to the place where consumption
- 15 is intended to occur; and
- 16 (b) For establishments licensed to sell alcohol for consumption off
- 17 the premises, notice shall be posted where the selection of the
- 18 beverage occurs.

- 1 (3) The board shall adopt rules determining sign placement, sign 2 size, print size, and typeface.
- 3 (4) The board shall supply the signs to retail licensees and shall 4 charge liquor suppliers for the cost of design, production, 5 distribution, and replacement of signs. Costs to manufacturers of 6 liquor shall be adopted by rule by the board.
 - (5) The board shall adopt rules to enforce this section.
